Guidance of the Holy Spirit

Acts 16:16-40

Evangelism can only be done by the work of God. At times, there are hardships. In that time, you can testify your confession of faith regarding the Gospel and evangelism. Satan will use any schemes to hinder evangelism, so you must keep in mind to not be deceived by Satan. May you never forget that those who hold to the covenant will always be victorious. God desires for evangelism to take place. That is His absolute plan.

1. **Slave girl who had a spirit of divination**

- 1) 16 : As we were going to the place of prayer - Centered on prayer
- 2) 17 : The demons know who you are.
(1) She kept doing for many days (Prayer, God's time schedule)
- 3) 18 : The authority of Christ (Genesis 3:15, 1 John 3:8)
- 4) The issue of age is spiritual healing.

2. **Miracles arose in the midst of persecution**

- 1) 22 : Tore the garments off and gave orders to beat them with a rod.
- 2) 25 : Praying and singing hymns at night.
- 3) 26 : There was a great earthquake, so the foundations of the prison were shaken.
- 4) 31 : Believe in the Lord Jesus.
- 5) 32-34 : They spoke the Word of the Lord to him and all who were in the house.
- 6) 37 : The reason Paul showed he was a Roman citizen later - He knew there was God's plan.

3. **The ministry in Philippi**

- 1) Centered on prayer (Door, the disciple that is responsible of the region)
- 2) Guidance of the Holy Spirit
- 3) Centered on the disciples
- 4) Left behind the disciples that continued the movement

4. **Conclusion**

- 1) If those who have the Gospel testify the Gospel, then the doors will be opened and disciples will be attached.
- 2) There is God's plan in all incidents that arise.
- 3) To the end, you must endure, pray, and wait.
- 4) Paul had assurance that God was always with him. He had faith that there is God's plan in the midst of persecution. Therefore, Paul purposely went to prison, prayed, and praised God.
