# The Potter

Romans 9:19-29

The world will go according to God's plan. There are no exceptions, and everything will take place according to the Word. The world will naturally become like the Book of Revelations and Jesus will come again. When He comes, He will not die on the cross once again but will come to judge. He will judge all the sins that have been committed since the creation of the world. After judgment, sinners and Satan will be imprisoned in eternal curses. The word of John 5:24 and John 3:16 may be common but to the world it is very important and it is the truth. You have been blessed to receive faith by the grace of God before creation. ## 1. The potter

- 1) The word "potter" is a controversial topic for those that are prepared to fall into destruction. They receive curses and are sinners without being given any chance. It is a very pitiful thing. Although it is wrongful towards them, you must be thankful for this grace to that extent. This was a decision that was made before creation and before you were born. You are here because you were given this grace.
- 2) You must be thankful to the extent that you don't know what else to do. You must be thankful to the extent to which you cannot express it, but you must also be inside of the mystery of prayer. However, you must confirm and realize that those who do not have this grace do not feel wronged for this. They have no interest in it. Even if you tell them to believe, they will not. Therefore, it is rather more peaceful and must be grateful.
- 3) They might view this to be biased and an unreasonable grace, but no one could know the reason for this decision because it is a decision that makes God happy. There is no relation to you.
- 4) The potter speaks of God's absolute sovereignty. This relates to your salvation and everything in your life. Absolute sovereignty means that there is no coincidence. There are no exceptions or reasons.
- 5) Even the hairs of your head are all numbered (Matthew 10:30) and Psalms 139:2 states, "You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar." Psalms 139:4 states, "Even before a word is on my tongue, behold, O Lord, you know it altogether."
- 6) Thinking about God like this as you live is 24 hours. You must think about God's plan in response to all things in life and you must find God's meaning behind it. This is because God will be there and He is looking over it.
- 7) God is the potter and He has absolute sovereignty. He is almighty, there is nothing that He does not know, and He makes the future. Therefore, it is the best for you when God makes decisions in your life according to what He desires. Answers to prayers are also decided by God's time schedule and you must be content by this. ## 2. The disciples

- 5) You must receive the answers like Apostle Paul's ministry that has taken place in Acts 2 for the work of 3,000 and 5,000 people who were added to the Lord. With this, Apostle Paul was attached to disciples and many saw great evidence.
- 6) Your spiritual eyes must be opened to see how the Apostle Paul evangelized. Onesimus was a slave, yet he was raised as a Pastor in the Colossae church. If a pastor does not have knowledge and evidence, then the ministry will be in vain. It was an age that the Holy Spirit was at work.
- 7) After Apostle Paul's third mission journey, Jason was appointed to lead the Thessalonica church. Later, the church was complimented by God. It was the church that received the Word of faith, hope, and love. Then, it is important for you to see what kind of disciple Jason was.
- 8) Priscilla and Aquila testified the Gospel in Scriptures to Apollos. Apollos was a well learned man and he gained insight of the Scriptures through Priscilla and Aquila. Apollos asked Priscilla and Aquila questions regarding the Scriptures and they gave the accurate answer according to the Scriptures. Apollos would not have let it slide.
- 9) Lydia was called as the spiritual leader in the region of Philippi after Apostle Paul had left. There are many aspects that you must consider regarding Lydia.
- 10) To what extent did the lay leader disciples prepare for the sake of the church? This is something you must think about.
- 11) Jeremiah 33:2, "Thus says the Lord who made the earth, the Lord who formed it to establish it- The Lord is His name." This verse is more important than Jeremiah 33:3. God who works, creates and fulfills it.
- 12) The disciples must go inside this principle. God who does everything according to His will. It is the plan that is unchanging. All that is left for you to do is to obey Him. You must completely obey His absolute plan. You must obey God. Your assertion is not needed.
