The Resurrection that Saves

Acts 9:1-9

Today is the day we commemorate the resurrection of our Lord and hold onto the covenant of His resurrection once again. May the blessing of reviving your life be upon you. The world is not easy, but there are people around us who live their lives as if they have conquered the world. These are the so-called successful 10% of people. But the majority live a very difficult life. Sometimes there are problems that have been passed down from generation to generation, such as fate, and there are also spiritual problems, such as mass shootings in American schools, which we often hear about. The answer that God has given to this problem is the blood of the promise which is the precious blood of Jesus Christ. Those who held onto this blood without hesitation conquered their fate and prevented the disasters of the age. They are the ones who changed the stream of the world into the stream of God. The resurrection is proof that the covenant alone is the answer. The resurrection of Christ is proof that all of His promises are true, and the message is that with this covenant alone, you can revive your life and save others. May you once again hold on to the covenant, have victory, restore all things, and stand as a witness.

1. The resurrection that saves

- 1) You do not have to die because Jesus resurrected. This is not only in a spiritual sense, but your physical body will not die but rather conquer. You will conquer the world, the future, and death. It is not something you do. It is what God does.
- 2) This is God's promise. He proved this promise through the resurrection of Jesus. Your soul and life will be saved for this is God's covenant. You can be like Hezekiah when you are upright to the covenant.
- 3) Hezekiah was upright to the blood of the promise that God gave him. The resurrection occurred within his physical life because he acted upon the Word without hesitation.
- 4) Hezekiah became the bartizan before all of the kings that were conquered by Assyria. A small nation that overcame many other nations killed the entire Assyrian army in one night and their king, who was worshiping and boasting about his idol, was stabbed to death by his own son.
- 5) King Hezekiah did not fight in the battle. No one went near the Assyrian army and not one arrow was shot in their direction. However, their army and king were all killed. This is a representative example of when they had victory without fighting.
- 6) This is a historical message. It is a message that with this blood of the covenant, you can have victory without fighting. No matter how big a nation or problem is, it does not matter. You must simply be upright in only your covenant and follow His Word without hesitation.
- 7) You must stake your life, be upright, and follow without hesitation as you do only. You will receive the unique answer when you live upright to the covenant even without any method. There was no nation or person that could overcome Assyria, but Judah, a tiny nation, conquered them.
- 8) This is the answer to uniqueness and work of recreation. Hezekiah was one that wrote history in that region and changed the stream. Assyria was the stream of that age, but God Almighty changed that stream.
- 9) You are one who has this fundamental Gospel and knows the authority of the blood of the covenant. Everything differs upon whether or not you are upright within this.
- 10) Those who have this as their fundamental will receive the blessing of 24 hour prayer and become the bartizan of Latin America and the Americas. The reason you must raise the bartizan is the resurrection for the content of the bartizan is the blood of the covenant.
- 11) This is because you can crush Satan's head with the blood of the covenant and it is God's only desire to bring His people out of curses. The resurrection is the evidence that God will do this on earth. The resurrection of the Lord saves you. It will save your soul and your physical life.
- 12) This is why Jesus physically died. In this, your spiritual resurrection is included. May you receive the grace to deeply enjoy this, have victory, and conquer.

2. Paul's resurrected life

- 1) Whoever receives Christ will have their lives resurrected. It is the resurrection that saves even now and in the future. What saves all is the resurrection. (Romans 8:1-2)
- 2) Today's passage is regarding Paul who met resurrected Christ. It was the moment that he came to the answer of Jesus Christ. He was a completely different person and his life was recreated and resurrected in Christ.
- 3) In 2 Corinthians 5:17, Paul states that he is a new creation and his life was completely overturned after he met Christ. He became the best figure of that time after his life was resurrected in Christ. He was the best creation of that time in God's eyes.
- 4) He was influential. In the time that was filled with the culture of the Greeks and Jews, he overturned it to the culture of Christianity in the world. Apostle Paul started the stream of the Gospel movement just as it was the same for slavery movement.
- 5) He was the main figure that changed the course of the history of the world. In Acts 16, Paul wanted to go to Asia to testify the Gospel, but he saw a vision of a man that told him to go to Macedonia. Not only did the direction of the Gospel movement change, but the history of the world as well.
- 6) There was a great revival that arose in Europe and Asia through the Gospel that is God's standard. They became a powerful nation with the Gospel that surpassed England and Germany. Rightfully, revival and great conquest of the world arose.
- 7) Those who have the covenant and desire to restore it in the world will be used to save the world. Apostle Paul and Hezekiah were those figures who were used for God's work. They rewrote the history of the world and changed the stream. Apostle Paul overturned the history of the world with the Gospel.
- 8) He not only changed the history of the world, but was used as the main figure to change the spiritual work that arose in the Bible as well. He had the understanding of the Gospel to which it was revealed upon the fields and he became the model of Biblical evangelism. Also, he unceasingly prayed and is a model of prayer.
- 9) Apostle Paul was alone, but the work that God has done through him cannot be fully expressed in words. King Hezekiah, who was upright to the covenant and Paul who came to the answer of Christ who has resurrected are the figures that must be seen as a model.
- 10) You can rewrite the history of America. The church will rewrite the history of Latin America and change the stream. You will be used to change the stream of the demonic culture. Through that the healing of the 3 ages of the churches in America. You will be used to change the stream of the churches of America. May this blessing be upon you.
- 11) For the sake of this, you must be upright and only the Gospel for that is the spiritual sacrifice. May the great work of conquest be upon the church.
