Acts 13:1-3

God desires to save many with the Gospel. That is evangelism. Therefore, the Bible clearly and specifically states evangelism. The evangelism that is written in the Bible is God's evangelism and the greatest evangelism. Along with the Gospel and evangelism, you must come to know God's principles. Along with the Gospel, you must have the overall picture. This is the direction and guidepost you must take.

1. What to prepare first - Fundamental

- 1) The church that has the Gospel
- 2) The disciples who have the mission
- 3) Field committed worker
- 4) The leader who has the overall picture - Field conductor

2. Paul's 1st evangelism journey

- 1) 2-3: The start was through prayer
- 2) Testifying the Gospel and many miracles - The start to seek the disciples in the fields.
 - (1) 13:11-12 They believed after seeing the work upon the proconsul.
 - (2) 14:3 The people of the city were divided.
 - (3) 14:8 A man at Lystra who could not walk.

3. Characteristics

- 1) The accurate Gospel - The severe work of Satan
 - (1) 13:8 Elymas the magician
 - (2) 13:44 The whole city gathered
 - (3) 14:11 They believed the gods had come down to them in the likeness of men.
 - (4) 14:19 They dragged him out of the city supposing that he was dead.
- 2) The synagogue was prepared in advance. – 13:5, 14, 44, 14:1
 - (1) 13:42 "That these things might be told to them in the next Sabbath."
 - (2) 13:43 Devout converts, Greeks
- 3) To see the overall timeline - To see the time schedule of the fields.

4. Conclusion

- 1) If you receive the Gospel, then history will arise. Satan will be at work as much as the Gospel is accurate.
- 2) There is always persecution, temptations, and deceptions. It is abnormal if it did not happen. (13:45)
- 3) "As many were appointed to eternal life believed." God never fails. (13:48)

2nd Evangelism Journey

Acts 16:11-15

The core point of the Biblical evangelism strategy is team ministry. Team ministry evangelism will be a way to open the doors of the Gospel in the region. Paul's 2nd evangelism journey showed important evidence of this. It is the complete and perfect evangelist that was led by the Holy Spirit. Evangelism starts with forming the system, conquering the world, and saving it.

1. **Evangelism in Philippi - Lydia**

- 1) 6-10: The complete guidance of the Holy Spirit
- 2) 11-15: Meeting with Lydia
- 3) 16-18: Healing the girl of spirit divination
- 4) 19-40: The Jailer and his family
- 5) The accurate Gospel and the complete guidance of the Holy Spirit in prayer

2. **Evangelism in Thessalonica - Jason**

- 1) 17:2 And Paul went in.
- 2) 4-5: Some followed and others didn't.
- 3) 10-15: Evangelism in Berea
 - (1) 14-15: Paul left Silas and Timothy.
- 4) Along with the disciples, they sought new disciples. The disciples continued the follow-up ministry.

3. **Evangelism in Corinth - Priscilla and Aquila**

- 1) 2-4: The accurate meeting - The meeting that had God's reason - Synagogue
- 2) 5: Silas and Timothy joined. - Paul was occupied with the Word.
- 3) 9-11: Word movement took place for a year and six months.
- 4) 12-17: He was taken by the law. - Sosthenes, the ruler of the synagogue.
- 5) 18-22: Priscilla and Aquila went along with him.

4. **Conclusion**

- 1) Ministry centered on the disciples. - The meeting with the prepared ones - Continuation arose in the region.
- 2) The reason for the Biblical evangelism movement - Accurate Gospel, God's desire, and guidance of the Holy Spirit.
- 3) God's evangelism will arise in the place that God desires with the one whom God has prepared.

3rd Evangelism Journey

Acts 19:8-12

You must view Apostle Paul's 3rd evangelism journey as the evangelism that you must head towards. To share the Gospel and for one to receive it is the fundamental of evangelism. However, God's goal for evangelism is to reach the ends of the world. If it is to the ends of the earth, then it can not merely end with one receiving the Gospel. Therefore, the Bible states to the ends of the earth as the model for evangelism. You can interpret Apostle Paul's evangelism as a model that went to the ends of the earth.

1. **Evangelism in Asia - Disciple Word movement**

- 1) 8-9: He set apart the disciples and spoke the Word to them every day.
- 2) 10: It continued for two years.
 - (1) 10: Both Jews and Greeks heard the Word.
 - (2) 12: Amazing power of God was at work.
 - (3) 19: Fifty thousand pieces of silver
- 3) 20: The word of the Lord prevailed mightily.

2. **I must see Rome as well**

- 1) 22: Timothy and Erastus were sent to Macedonia.
- 2) 20:1 He went to Macedonia as well.
- 3) 20:2-3 He stayed there for three months.
- 4) 20:4 They went to Asia with him.
- 5) 20:6 They met in Troas.

3. **Constrained by the Holy Spirit (20:22)**

- 1) 17: Called the elders of the church to come to him.
- 2) 36-38: They all wept.
- 3) On the way to Jerusalem
 - (1) 3-4: Cyprus to Tyre
 - (2) 7: He stayed at Ptolemais for a day.
 - (3) 8-10: He stayed with Philip the evangelist for many days.
 - (4) 16: Some of the disciples from Caesarea and an early disciple, Mnason from Cyprus.

4. **Conclusion**

- 1) Evangelism is the Word movement that the minister does with the disciples.
- 2) The doors will rightfully open if the Gospel is accurate and God's desire is connected.
- 3) The answer is given through the enjoyment of the covenant during scheduled prayer and summit time. This is the start of evangelism.
